**BMS-AAPS NIPER Student Chapter** invites abstracts from researchers and students in the areas of pharmaceuticals, pharmaceutical technology and pharmaceutical analysis for poster presentation in **BMS-AAPS NIPER Student Chapter One-day Symposium** to be held at **NIPER, Mohali on 30 Nov, 2018**. The work of the abstract should not have been presented at any other conference. Please read and follow the guidelines in the preparation of the abstracts. Only one paper per presenting author will be accepted.

### Awards

The three best posters will be selected for first award and two runner-ups.

### Mode of submission:

Electronic by e-mail as 'MS word2007 file attachment to be sent to: -

### File Format:

Abstracts in 'MSword2007file format, with tables, pictures and graphs embedded within the text of document. (ALL IN BLACK AND WHITE ONLY) are to be submitted.

The abstracts should be:

1. Be prepared as per the 'Abstract Submission Guidelines' given below.
2. Be written using simple scientific language to describe recent experiments, innovations and insights.
3. Include data, new concepts or approaches.
4. Ensure that all claims and conclusions are supported by data or references, especially those making comparisons to competing products.

**The deadline for poster abstract submission is 25<sup>th</sup> Nov 2018.**

Once you have submitted your abstract, you will receive an email acknowledging receipt.

**After review by an expert committee, the acceptance information will be mailed to you by 27 Nov 2018.**

### ABSTRACT SUBMISSION GUIDELINES:

**The theme of abstract should fall under following categories:**

1. Deliverability of molecules from biopharmaceutical perspective
2. Importance of material properties in biopharmaceutical performance
3. *In vitro*, *in silico* and *in vivo* tools for biopharmaceutical risk assessment

#### 4. Designing of drug delivery systems

##### **The abstract should be:**

- One A-4 size page long, when printed single-spaced with one-inch margins using Times New Roman, 12- point font to maximum word limit of **300 words**.

- Titles, Authors Institutions and Key Words: should be included in Times New Roman 12-pointfont.

b) The primary author (who will be presenting) should be underlined, followed by any other authors, using capitalized first letters only. Please provide full first and last names, and the middle initial of all authors.

The address of the primary author, including their company name (and optionally their department), city, state or province and country, should be listed. If the authors are associated with different institutions, the author(s) and institution(s) should be correctly associated with super scripted Arabic numbers (1, 2, 3, etc.).

d) No more than 5 key words to be included, which will help to quickly access your work from searchable database. Please try to avoid commonly used words.

##### **BODY OF THE TEXT:**

Please write under the following section headings in the order shown:

Introduction: should be as brief as possible, and should provide background information to understand the research work to be presented by you.

Main Sections: Please use appropriate sub headings to break up your work into appropriate sections, for example, METHODS, RESULTS, DATA ANALYSIS etc. In the end include a CONCLUSIONS section, to interpret the significance of your results.

References: All references, including URLs, must be numbered consecutively, in square brackets, in the order in which they are cited in the text and should follow the style given below.

##### **Instructions for Preparing the Posters and General Guidelines to Poster Presenters**

###### **Poster size- 33\*47 inches**

- A poster should be prepared in such a way that the delegates are able to quickly read and grasp the idea. Hence, they should be visually appealing and legible.

- Use large fonts and thick lines, include diagrams, tables and figures. The contents should be easily readable from a distance of 1 meter, so that more people can read your

poster at once.

Your poster content should not deviate from the main idea/theme of your published abstract. In the poster contents -

- Ensure that all claims and conclusions are supported by data on the poster or by references.
- Do not include speculative or unsubstantiated comments.
- You should be present at your poster at the dedicated time slots to interact with the delegates as much as possible.
- If you wish, you may bring copies of your poster (on A4 size paper) to be distributed to interested participants.
